To be considered for this bursary, students are required to submit a poster(s) with a description detailing a GIS project or application that they have worked on during their studies. We only accept an individual project. ***Unfortunately, we are unable to accept submissions from doctoral students and/or group projects.*

The BeSpatial / urisa ontario board of directors will review the submissions and publish the three best submissions in one of our e-News editions and post on the education webpage.

Descriptions should be no longer than 1,000 words and include an explanation of the project, its purpose and the solution that it will provide.

This is a great opportunity for students to get name recognition and begin participating within the geospatial and information community. A complimentary student membership is offered to each of the top 10 submissions.
